Article I: *Name*

Article III: *Membership*

Section 1. Membership shall be limited to those students in grades ____

Section 3. Membership shall be equally apportioned from the grades indicated in Section 1.

(The sections for Article III will vary according to the particular circumstances of each club)

Article IV: *Officers*

Section 1. Officer positions for this organization shall include _____. They shall serve for one year or until their successors are elected and qualify.

Section 2. Each officer shall be a member in good standing.

Article V: *Election of Officers*

Section 1. Election of new officers shall be conducted at a meeting during the month of _____

Section 2. All elections shall be held by secret ballot.

Section 3. A simple majority vote will constitute an election to office.

Article VI: *Meetings*

Section 1: The club shall hold regular weekly or monthly meetings at such time and place as shall be determined by the club with the approval of the school administration.

Article VII: *Removal Proceeding*

Section 1: Proceedings for the removal of any officer or representatives for failure to attend meetings, failures to represent his group properly and fairly, failure to carry out his duties, or for any other actions which are detrimental to the welfare of the school, can be initiated by the Faculty Advisor

Article VIII: *Amendments*

Section 1: Amendments to this constitution shall be adopted by two-thirds vote of the members present at a regular membership held as the next immediate meeting after one at which the proposed amendment was published either by being read or by its distribution in writing.
