WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE EXAM?

- **Thursday May 5th, 2022. Noon!**
- **In person, paper-and-pencil as far as we know.**
- **Graphing calculator required for both (multiple-choice & free response) portions of the exam.**
- **Reference sheet provided and permitted on both portions of the exam.**
- **Communication is as important (more?) as arithmetic on the AP Statistics exam. Students must be able to communicate and show work legibly, clearly, and concisely.**

WHAT MATERIALS ARE REQUIRED?

List in the Policies & Procedures which students need to print from Schoology!

3-ring binder (minimum 1-inch) containing all work completed in the class so far.

Charged internet-capable laptop or tablet, charger, and portable battery charger.

Thirteen 3-hole punched notebook dividers (1/chapter & 1 “AP Review”)

Pencil and at least 2 colored pencils for graphs and charts.

Red or green pen for making corrections.

8½ X 11 inch, 3-hole punched graph paper and blank (unlined) paper.

Graphing calculator (charged or with batteries). TI-84 family recommended or TI-Inspire.

12-inch ruler marked with both inches and centimeters.

HOW CAN I HELP MY CHILD SUCCEED IN THIS CLASS?

1. **Have a regular time you collect your child's phone to turn off and charge in your room overnight.**
2. **Ask for interim progress reports and report card when they are released, or sign up for electronic notifications.**
3. **Encourage daily study and practice, whether there is a specific homework assignment or not.**
4. **Encourage your child to take responsibility for his/her own learning.**
5. **Enable your child to get to school early/*stay late when needed* for makeup work or extra help.**

DO THEY HAVE HOMEWORK? WHEN IS THE NEXT QUIZ?

All assignments are listed in advance on Schoology on the day they are due.

Students are responsible for all work assigned when they are present in class (or in Observation Mode) whether it appears in Schoology or not!

Tests and quizzes are posted as soon as they are announced in class.

If you would like to monitor your student's assignments, they will have to log in and show you the calendar.
