## HOW ARE YOU HANDLING COVID SAFETY?

#### WHAT IS "ADVANCED TOPICS?"

- This is not a test-prep class. However, almost every topic in this course is included on the SAT, or is a prerequisite skill for SAT topics.
- Not going to put students "behind." Precalculus as a senior is the typical "college bound" course.

#### HOW CAN I HELP MY CHILD SUCCEED IN THIS CLASS?
